ELECTORAL COLLEGE TO MEET AT STATE CAPITOL

Secretary of State Jay Dardenne is announcing the meeting of the Louisiana Electoral College on Monday, Dec. 15 at 11 a.m. in the governor's Press Room on the 4th Floor of the State Capitol. Secretary Dardenne will administer oaths of office to the nine electors of the Republican Party prior to their votes for president and vice president of the United States.

The electors are: Dianne Christopher, at large; Roger F. Villere Jr., at large; Lynn E. Skidmore, 1st Congressional District; Joe Lavigne, 2nd Congressional District; Billy Nungesser, 3rd Congressional District; Alan Seabaugh, 4th Congressional District; Karen Haymon, 5th Congressional District; Charles Davis, 6th Congressional District; and Charlie Buckels, 7th Congressional District. In the event that one of these electors is not present, an alternate elector will assume his or her duties.

The Electoral College, administered by the National Archives and Records Administration, is a process that began as part of the original design of the United States Constitution. The Founding Fathers established the Electoral College as a compromise between election of the president by Congress and election by popular vote. The people of the United States vote for the electors who then vote for the president.
